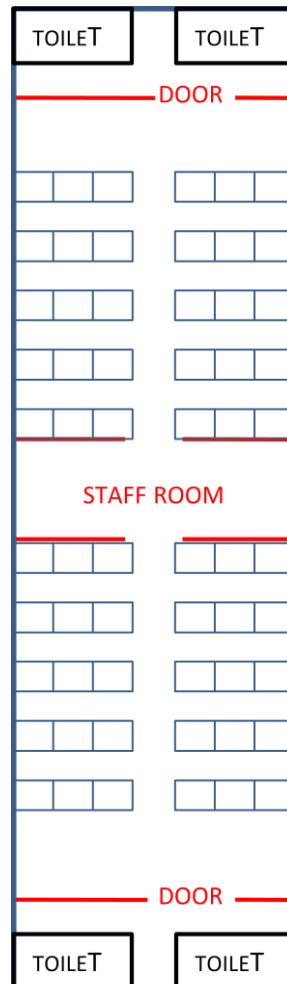


DECOMMISSIONED RAILWAY COACH - REFURBISHED AS CLASS ROOMS FOR VILLAGE SCHOOLS



In General a railway coach in India is decommissioned after 30 years. These coaches are invariably sent to scrap yard for re melting.

The above concept is to refurbish these coaches as class rooms. The wheels can be detached along with other unwanted parts and the coach mounted on suitable brick construction and steps provided. The coach can be placed under shady trees to provide a cooler temperature. Rain water harvesting can be provided. Other details will be provided later.

Two class rooms can be designed to seat 30 students each and a staff room in the centre. This design will provide two toilets for each class room. Girls and Boys will have separate toilets.

Connecting these refurbished coaches with electricity and drainage system will ensure clean, well ventilated and hygienic class rooms and toilets.
